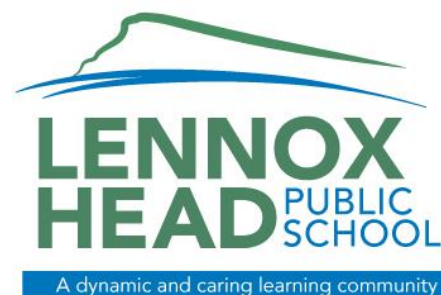

## Three Respects in Action – Dolphin Slips

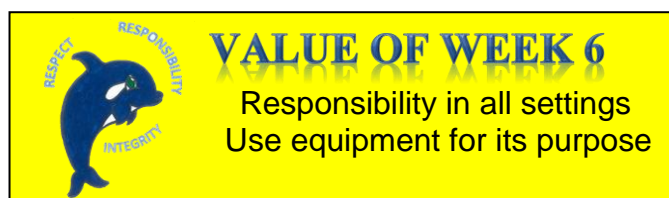
