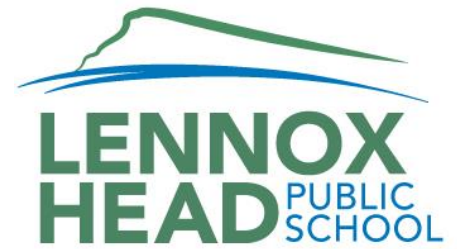

If they don't already have a bank account you can open up a Commonwealth Bank Youth Saver account for them. Instead, the program is designed to help show children that benefits of regular saving. Each deposit earns a token and 10 tokens can be redeemed for a variety of reward items. 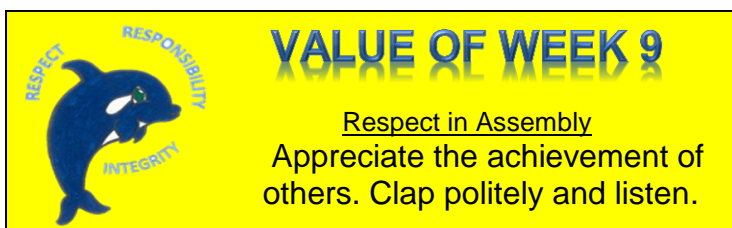

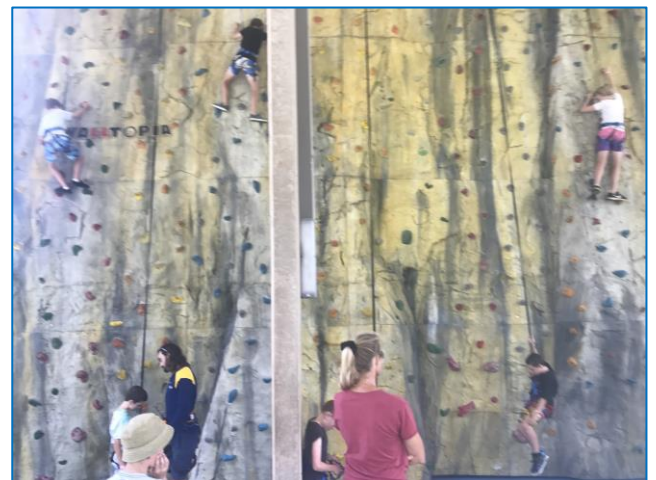

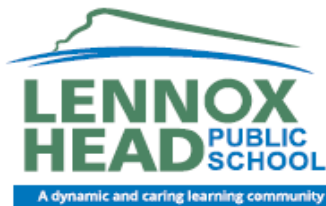
